SPRING BREAK AND REMOTE LEARNING DAY

TOMORROW, all students will be dismissed at noon for teacher in-service and to kick off their Spring break!

On Tuesday, Dec 6, we had to close the school due to a gas leak. Due to the quick notice, we were unable to have students gather schoolwork and be prepared for a Remote Learning Day. We need to "make up" that day in order to maintain the appropriate number of instructional days to meet state requirements; and so, we plan to have a Remote Learning Day on Monday, March 20, of Spring Break. We chose to have the Remote Learning Day during Spring Break instead of one of our previous days off from school so that families and students will have plenty of time to complete the schoolwork while also enjoying the break.

Teachers will have assignments posted in Canvas or will send papers in the Friday folders on March 17th. We understand that some families may be out of town for the entire Spring Break, so we are allowing students until Wednesday, March 29, to complete the assignments.

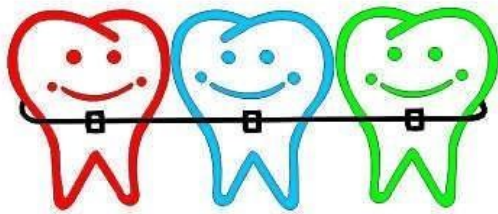

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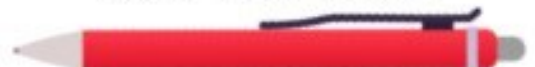
