RE-ENROLLMENT SEASON ENDS NEXT WEEK!

It is our sincere hope and desire that you and your family will Re-enroll for the upcoming 2019-20 school year. *Please remember that Re-Enrollment Season ends on Thursday*, *March 21st.* If you haven't submitted your Re-Enrollment application <u>AND</u> registration fee yet, we hope that you will do so, as soon as possible, in order to secure a spot for your child for the 2019-20 school year, AND take advantage of lower tuition rates.

Please keep in mind that if <u>BOTH</u> the application <u>AND</u> the fee are received after the deadline, you will not qualify for the lower tuition rates.

GCS Parents Can Earn Up to \$500 Towards Next Year's Tuition!

Bring in a new family for an initial interview, and you will receive a \$100 credit to your 2019-20 tuition account. **ALSO**, if that family enrolls, then both YOU and the NEW FAMILY will receive a \$400 credit towards tuition for the month of January, 2020, for one student!

The following rules and restrictions apply:

- Each interviewing family MUST designate one existing GCS family on the coupon to receive the credit at the initial interview. Credit will not be given at a later date.
- Credits are limited to only one credit per interviewing family.
- The \$400 tuition credit will be applied in January, 2020, to the designated family account.
- Offer good only for interviews beginning Mar 1-Aug 1, 2019.

SENIOR HIGH FINE ARTS COMPETITION






