STUDENT POLICIES FOR INTERNET USAGE

- A. Students should not access the Internet during class time unless an assignment specifically requires Internet use or the instructor gives permission for access.
- B. Certain material available on the Internet is inherently inappropriate for student use. Examples include: material that is of a sexually explicit nature, homosexuality, or that advocates violence against women, minorities, ethnic groups, government, etc.; humor of an offensive or sexually explicit nature, and pirated commercial software. Students may not send messages during class time unless instructed to do so by the teacher. Students may not send messages that are obscene, threatening, or of sexually explicit nature. Personal Internet sites such as Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, Tic-Toc, etc., should not be accessed during school hours.
- C. Students may not access files belonging to other students unless instructed to by the teacher.

PENALTY: In the event of an Internet violation the parents will be notified and the student will be subject to a level 5 disciplinary action as laid out in the Student Handbook.
